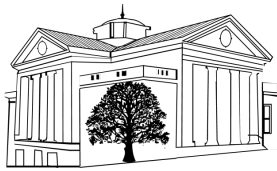

The Trustees met and then voted to approve the plan proposed by Arthur Schleuter. On July 10th, at 6:30PM in the Fellowship Hall, the Church Council will hold an open meeting to discuss this proposal and its funding. The total cost will be \$268,048.00.
