Class 1A (Caterpillars: 6 weeks-12 months.): sleep sacks, soft families, folding floor chairs, yummy plush play food, and soft touch cute baby animals

Class 1B (Bumble Bees: 10 months-18 months): hands free trash can, hardcover books, bubble machine, play food

Class 2 (Ladybugs: 12-24 months): climbing toys, walking push toys, sand/water table, battery powered book (see and say), board books
