Through much prayer and discernment the organ committee, after meeting for the last year has presented to the Trustees three options for the renovation of the beautiful instrument that blesses Asbury on Sunday morning. The Trustees met and then voted to approve the plan proposed by Arthur Schleuter. On July 10th, the Church Council will hold an open meeting to discuss this proposal and it's funding. The total cost will be \$268,048.00.
